## about the position

- Act as lead architectural technologist, working as part of a collaborative team of architects, interior designers, technologists, consultants, contractors, and owners.
- Participate in firm-wide planning relative to design technology innovation & implementation.
- Create well-organized and innovative workflows through document/model production, coordination, and output.
- Create clear and crafted architectural details that bring ideas from conception to construction, integrating strong constructibility and durability principals.
- Create, analyze, verify, and manage drawings and BIM content templates, and libraries.
- Update and consolidate BIM model content and perform clash detection throughout projects.
- Produce firm-wide standards for BIM (both design and construction documents); templates, families, and standards documents and details; development of f-BLOK BIM Best Practices documents and training.
- Conduct evaluation of existing building conditions and document building components.
- Communicate with the office and share lessons learned and best practices on a regular basis.
- Mentor team members and up-and-coming technologists and designers.
